

MAKE OR BREAK Presented by Be A Broadway Star
3-6 players

## OBJECT

The object of the game is to acquire the most gigs.

## GAME PREPARATION

Before beginning the game, decide on how many auditions will be played and how many players. We recommend a total of 6-10 Auditions for 3-6 players, however more can be played for a longer game.

Each player should take a stack of Make or Break Cards for when it's their turn to be the Producer.

## GAME PLAY

If any player's first name is "Tony" that player automatically is first to draw a Make or Break Card. This player acts as the "Producer" for that turn and reads the card aloud to the other players, who will be performing the action on the card.

The other players must then audition by completing the task on the Card. The Producer then decides who deserves the "gig" and the winner of that round keeps the Make or Break Card until the end of the game.

If the Make or Break Card requires the players to list out names of shows, songs, or anything other than actually performing, players should write their answers out on a sheet of paper other than saying them aloud.

The play then continues around the room clockwise, with each player taking a turn as the Producer until all Make or Break Cards are gone.

## WINNING

Once all Make or Break Cards have been played, each player
 should count the number of Cards they have. The winner is the player with the most Make or Break cards to their name at the end of the game. This player wins the Tony Award!
