But that's exactly when you WANT to put your stuff out there. And if you get an opportunity to be around people who have more experience or people who you look up to in terms of their skill sets, that's when you MUST take advantage of it.

The same is true for any skill you want to improve.

Want to play better poker? Play with great players.

Want to be a better musician? Join a band with musicians who are better than you.
