Todd Faulkner is the co-creator and a primary writer of the award-winning podcast Uncanny County, an anthology of fully-produced audio plays featuring supernatural tales of the American Southwest (think *Twilight Zone* as it might have been imagined by the Coen Brothers). He comes a long line of outlaws, raconteurs, and well-meaning shape-shifters. Todd grew up in Oklahoma City and lived all over the United States before finally settling down in New York, where he co-produced (with his wife, Nicole Greevy) and directed the webseries Exorcists Local 667 (Official Selection, ITV Fest) and Extreme Parenting. Todd also co-produced/directed the independent television pilot Living in Captivity (Official selection, NYTVF and ITV Fest). As an actor, Todd appeared Off-Broadway in the York Theatre's critically acclaimed production of Yank! and has appeared in recurring roles on many NYC-based television shows, most prominently appearing as Agent Loeb of FX's The Americans.
